



Sleeping Securely: An Analysis of Consumer Reports on Cribs at SaferProducts.Gov

Between March 14, 2011 and May 27, 2012, SaferProducts.gov received and posted 174 consumer reports that described incidents involving cribs. A crib is the one place where parents and caregivers should not have to worry about their child's safety. However, the majority of deaths associated with nursery products occur in sleeping environments. Between 2006 and 2008, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) reported 304 deaths related to nursery products. Out of these deaths, 41% were connected to cribs or mattresses and 19% to faulty bassinets and cradles¹. In the last 20 years, 1,100 children have died in crib related incidents with an average of 30 children dying a year in cribs².

Tyler was ten months old when his mother found him strangled in his Child Craft drop-side crib. A screw had become loose, creating a gap between the side rail and headboard of the crib. The gap trapped Tyler's neck, strangling him to death³. The crib was never recalled.

In the last four years, CPSC has taken steps to greatly improve crib safety. In 2008, sweeping legislation passed which required that toys and infant products be tested before they are sold. Stricter standards for cribs were adopted in 2010 and it is now illegal to manufacture or sell cribs that have don't meet the new standards, including a ban on drop-side cribs, increased slat strength, anti-loosening devices for hardware, more durable mattress support, and rigorous safety testing⁴.

This research report examines reports on cribs posted on SaferProducts.gov from March 14, 2011 through May 27, 2012. This report will consider some of the hazards related to the cribs reported during this period, as well as resulting injuries. It will examine the age of cribs, standards applied based on manufacture date, and recalls of unsafe cribs.

Hazards and Injuries

There were eight categories of hazards reported between May 14, 2011 and May 27, 2012: breakage, choking/ingestion, entrapment, entrapment in slats, fall, laceration, poison, and strangulation. Three of the reports did not classify as any of these categories and instead categorize as recalled, unspecified, or does not meet standards. Below is a graph documenting

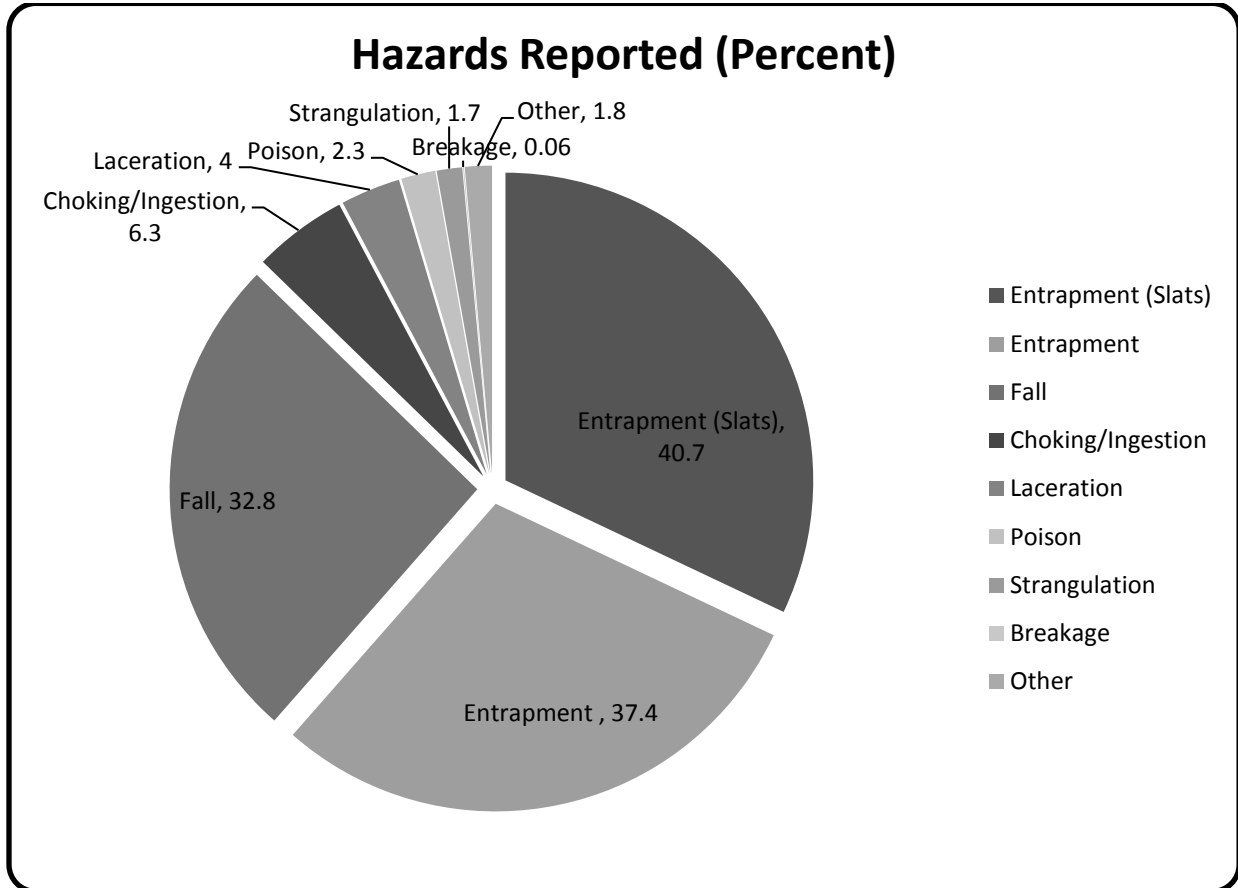

the percentage of reports linked to each hazard. Please note that some incidents classify as more than one hazard, for example, strangulation *and* entrapment or entrapment *and* fall.



The most common hazards are entrapment in slats, entrapment, and fall. In addition to types of hazards, the reports also document the severity of the injury, if any. The table below lists the number of reports involving each category of victim severity.

Certain hazards resulted in injury more often than others did. The table below documents the number of hazards reported and the percentage of incidents related to that hazard that resulted in injury or death.

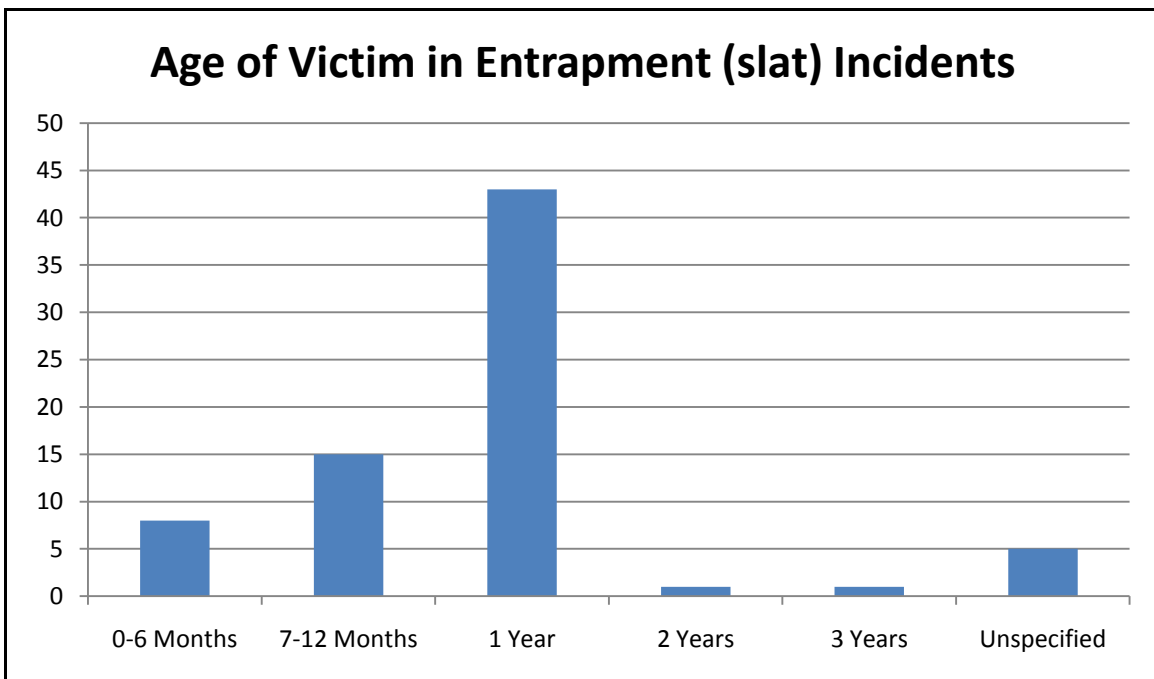

The two hazards that most frequently result in injury are poison (three out of the four incidents resulted in injury) and entrapment in slats. A combined strangulation and entrapment hazard was responsible for the single death reported.

Slats

Entrapment in slats was both the most commonly reported hazard and one of the hazards that most frequently resulted in some form of injury. The majority of these injuries are minor, as seen in the statistics below:

- 37.5 % classified under Injury, No First Aid or Medical Treatment Received
- 20.8% Injury, First Aid Received by Non-Medical Professional
- 8.3% Injury, Level of Care Not Known
- 1.4% Injury, Emergency Department Treatment Received
- 27.8% Incident, No Injury



Crib bumpers, recently banned for sale in Chicago because of the suffocation risk they pose to babies, are often promoted as a means to keep children from getting their limbs stuck in slats. It is typically recommended to caregivers that they remove bumpers around the age of 6 months, when the baby can start to pull him or herself up—and possibly use the bumper as a means to topple out of the crib. However, the data from recent reports show that the vast majority of children who are getting their limbs stuck in slats are *over a year old*. According to this data, then, bumpers, if used according to instruction, would do little to prevent entrapment in slats, since it seems to occur more frequently among toddlers, rather than babies.

Manufacture and Purchase Dates

Stricter crib standards went into effect during the period this research report examines, so the reports posted on SaferProduct.gov include both cribs that are outdated and cribs that have met

the new standards. The table below lists crib's manufacture dates. Out of these reports, 113 or approximately 65% of the reports did not include the manufacture date.

Twenty-three percent of the cribs reported in incidents have a manufacture date that is within the past five years.

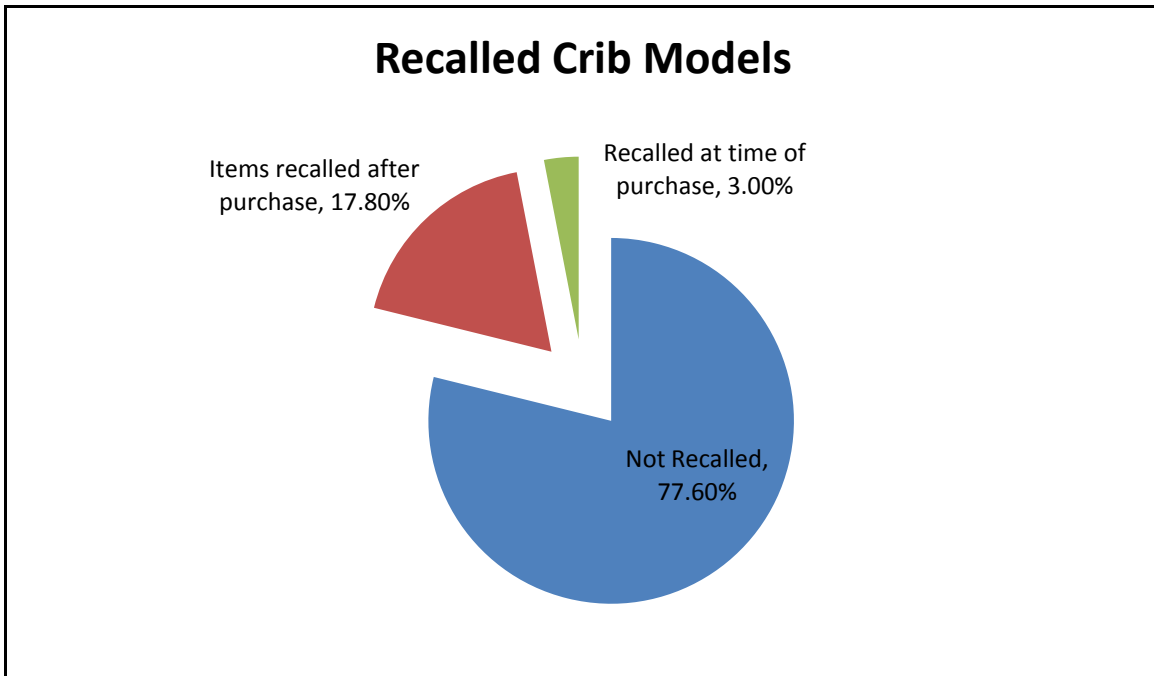
Out of the 61 cribs with manufacture dates, six had manufacture dates after December 28, 2010, the date that stricter standards went into effect for manufacturers. These models had manufacture dates between January 1st, 2011 and September 1st, 2011.

The vast majority of cribs reported had a purchase date that was within the past five years. Fifteen had purchase dates after June 28, 2011, the last possible day to sell cribs that had not met new standards, indicating that these cribs should meet the new standards.

Recalls

Thirty-six out of 174 reports or 20.7% of the reports involved recalled models. Five of those reports on recalled cribs, or approximately 14% of those reports, reported cribs that had already been recalled *at the time the crib was purchased*. The graph below notes the percentage of cribs that were recalled at the time of purchase and the percentage of cribs that had already been recalled at the time of the incident in relation to the total number of reports.



The five reports documenting recalled cribs at the time of the purchase raise some important questions. Where did the consumer acquire this item? The table below notes the recall date for each of the eight reports, the date the consumer acquired the recall crib, and the place that the consumer acquired the crib.

In the majority of the reports, the consumer acquired the crib as a second-hand purchase or gift. One report lists a major retail store – Wal-Mart -- as the place of purchase. This is alarming because it implies that major retail stores, which would ostensibly only sell safe products, are still selling items that have been recalled, even as late as three years after the date of recall. This is in addition to the number of recalled cribs caregivers can purchase at second-hand stores or sales.

Conclusions and Recommendations

Despite recent steps taken to address crib product safety, unsafe cribs are still in widespread circulation. Given the timing, only a fraction (3%) of the cribs in the reports were manufactured under the tough new standard – and one can assume these older cribs will remain in homes for some years to come. Approximately 9% of cribs purchased had a purchase date after June 28, 2011, the last day which retailers could sell cribs that had not met the new standards. The vast majority of cribs reported had a purchase date within the last five years and a majority of the cribs whose manufacture dates were available also had a manufacture date that dated within the last five years. This find indicates that even recent models pose hazards to children.

Thirty-nine of the reports reported recalled products. In eight of those reports, the products were already recalled when the caregivers acquired them. Some of the caregivers acquired them at major retail places such as Wal-Mart and Babies R' Us. This is a serious concern because it could indicate that these places are either not aware of or are not heeding recalls. Four of the caregivers either purchased the recalled product used or received it as a gift. This is also a major concern because it indicates that recalled products are still in circulation. All of these products had a purchase date within the last two years, between 2010 and 2012.

Ensuring Your Crib Meets New CPSC Standards⁵

- Cribs that are drop side do not meet the new standards and should be replaced.
- If you purchased your crib after June 2011, it should meet the new standards; a certificate of compliance that it meets 16 CFR 1219 or 1220 confirms this.
- If you bought a crib in 2010 or 2011 that is not a drop-side, you can contact the manufacturer to see if they have a certificate of compliance that meets the new standards. You can find the manufacturer's name, date of manufacture, and contact information on the tracking label of the crib.

Ensuring Crib Safety⁶

- Carefully read instructions for set up, use, and care of the crib
- No soft bedding such as pillows, blankets, bumpers, or stuffed animals
- Use a tight fitting sheet on the mattress
- Mattress should be in the lowest position once that child can pull himself or herself up
- Mattress must be tight fitting
- Check that mattress support system is connected on all four sides of the crib and that all hardware is tight and in good condition
- No loose or missing hardware such as screws and bolts
- Crib should be free of protruding metal nuts or bolts, knobs, rivets etc.
- Any mobiles, toys etc. should be out of the baby's reach and removed once the baby starts sitting or standing
