# NURSERY PRODUCT RECALLS IN 2023 HIGHEST IN OVER A DECADE

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### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Since 2002, KID has released an annual report detailing the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC)'s children's product recalls from the previous year. This year's report examines children's product recalls in 2023.

#### The main findings of this report include:

- The number of nursery product recalls (26) this year is the highest since 2012 (30). Eleven
  of these recalls and 20 additional warnings were due to suffocation hazards because the
  products violated various federal safety regulations for infant sleep products that
  recently went into effect.
- The CPSC recalled a water bead product for the first time since 2013. The Chuckle & Roar
  Ultimate Water Beads Activity Kits were sold exclusively at Target and were recalled
  after an infant death was reported.
- The CPSC released 35 warnings without a recall regarding children's products or adult products that could hurt children in 2023, much higher than in 2022 (5 warnings).
- This year, 84,054,411 units were recalled primarily due to one product accounting for 83% of units recalled, the Candy Dynamics Slime Licker Sour Rolling Liquid Candy (70,000,000 units). A similar product, the Cocco Candy and KGR Distribution Cocco's Candy Rolling Candy, caused a death due to choking hazard.
- There were two recalls and 12 unilateral notifications for small powerful magnet products. These products failed to comply with a CPSC federal standard that went into effect in December 2022.
- The number of recalls due to burn hazard and choking hazard were the highest this year with 25 recalls and 21 recalls respectively.
- There were six deaths reported prior to recall this year and four of them were due to choking and ingestion hazards.
- The CPSC translated 64% of children's product recalls to Spanish, an increase from 2022 where zero children's product recalls were translated to Spanish.
- Social media usage by the CPSC and recalling companies to alert consumers about recalled products remained low. The CPSC posted 44% of children's product recalls on Facebook and 45% on Twitter. However, the CPSC has increased its Instagram use from 34% to 46%.

### **KID RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:**

- Recalling companies must use all tools at their disposal to retrieve recalled products. This includes social media for every recall, and other measures such as direct notification to consumers and marketing recalls to the same extent as they market products. Additionally, they should work with retailers, marketers, consumer groups and state and local governments to spread information about the recall more widely and to reach more consumers.
- The CPSC's social media has been getting attention due to their eclectic and viral
  posts. The CPSC could capitalize on this to reach more parents and caregivers of
  young children who are active on these sites by posting all recalls as soon as they
  are announced. Additionally, the CPSC should work with community groups to
  increase awareness of recalls, especially in Spanish-speaking communities.
- The CPSC should continue to issue unilateral notifications to consumers about a hazardous product when the company does not agree to a recall, and make every effort to get dangerous products recalled.
- Policymakers should ban the sale of water beads marketed to children, and the CPSC should recall those involved in injuries and deaths.
- Policymakers should implement a strong mandatory safety standard governing lithium-ion batteries in micro-mobility products.
- Policymakers should provide adequate funding for the CPSC to fulfill its mission.
- Online platforms should strengthen efforts to ensure all products sold on their sites are safe, meet any required standards and adequately warn consumers about product hazards.
- Product designers and manufacturers should create safe products that do not injure children. Resources such as the KID Design Safety Toolkit, CPSC's Small Business Ombudsman and services of industry associations and many others are accessible to assist in this.
- Parents and caregivers should report product incidents to the CPSC at SaferProducts.gov. They should also be proactive to keep up with recalls. They can subscribe to KID's newsletter to receive a monthly recall digest at www.kidsindanger.org.

### INTRODUCTION

KID's annual recall report examines data and trends in children's products that have been recalled jointly by the CPSC and companies. This year's report examines children's product recalls during the 2023 calendar year. Product recalls can begin in a variety of ways. For example, a recall can start with the report of an incident or injury to the CPSC by a consumer, the report of an unsafe product to the CPSC by the manufacturer of the product, or media coverage of a potentially dangerous product. If an injury or incident was reported, the CPSC uses this information to help decide if a product should be recalled, considering the severity of the incident or injury and how likely it is to reoccur. Once their product is recalled, all manufacturers are required to implement a Corrective Action Plan. A Corrective Action Plan includes any remedial actions taken to mitigate the potential hazard, as well as changes to design, manufacturing, materials, quality control, warnings, marketing, or discontinuing the product.

### **GENERAL RECALL TRENDS**

KID's report last year found that in 2022, there were 100 children's products recalls, the highest since 2013. This year the trend continues with 101 children's products recalls (32%) out of 312 total recalls issued by the CPSC. While the number of recalls is increasing over the past decade, this might not be cause for alarm, as this could be an indication the CPSC is working as intended and is recalling dangerous products effectively. This year, there was also an increase in the number of recalled units of children's products at 84,054,411 units. This high number is due to a few products that had millions of units recalled: the Epoch Everlasting Play Calico Critters Animal Figures and Sets sold with Bottle and Pacifier Accessories (3,200,000 units), the Zuru Robo Alive Junior Baby Shark Sing & Swim Bath Toys (full-size) and Robo Alive Junior Mini Baby Shark Swimming Bath Toys (mini-size) (7,500,000 units), and the Candy Dynamics Slime Licker Sour Rolling Liquid Candy (70,000,000 units). Monthly progress reports that companies provide on the effectiveness of their recall process are essential to determine how many units are recalled.




Figure 1. Number of Children's Products Recalls Remains High

### CPSC STARTED TRANSLATING RECALLS INTO SPANISH THIS YEAR

KID's report last year found that zero children's product recalls were translated to Spanish and KID called on the agency to translate recall press releases to alert the U.S.'s Spanish-speaking population to recalled products. The CPSC has started to translate recall press releases into Spanish, although the Spanish versions are not released until a couple weeks after the recall. In 2023, 64% of children's products recalls were translated into Spanish. This is a step in the right direction for the agency.

### NUMBER OF CPSC SAFETY WARNINGS INCREASE

In 2023, the CPSC continued releasing warnings and unilateral notifications to consumers regarding hazardous children's products. Unilateral notifications are public warnings of a hazard after engaging with the firm in an advance notice process, with an exception for a public announcement of a regulatory violation. The CPSC can issue unilateral notifications when firms are not responsive or out of business, if firms are unwilling to take corrective action, or if a proposed remedy is insufficient. The CPSC released 35 warnings regarding children's products or adult products that could hurt children in 2023, much higher than in 2022 (five warnings). Of these warnings, 20 were for infant sleep products that were recalled due to violating standards, 12 for small powerful magnet products, two for outdoor and sports products, and one for a chemical product that failed to meet child-resistant packaging requirements.




Figure 2. CPSC Released Most Warnings for Nursery Products

### RECALLS BY CATEGORY

Clothing product recalls were the top category in 2023 with 27 recalls, closely followed by nursery products with 26 recalls.

Furniture recalls decreased over the past four years. Alternatively, outdoor and sports recalls have gradually increased over the past five years with 15 recalls in 2023.




Figure 4. Nursery Products and Outdoor and Sports Recalls Higher than Previous Year

One candy product (categorized as Misc.), Candy Dynamics Slime Licker Sour Rolling Liquid Candy had over 70 million units recalled accounting for 83% of all units recalled in 2023. This product was recalled after the CPSC received a report of a 7-year-old girl who choked and died due to a very similar product also recalled this year, the Cocco Candy and KGR Distribution Cocco's Candy Rolling Candy.




Figure 5. Over 70 Million Units of Two Candy Recalls Account for 83% of All Units Recalled in 2023

### INCREASE IN NURSERY PRODUCT RECALLS






Figure 6. Nursery Product Recalls Highest in Eleven Years

This year, the number of nursery product recalls (26) is the highest since 2013 (25). Eleven of these recalls and the 20 infant sleep products the CPSC released unilateral notifications for were due to suffocation hazards because the products violated various federal safety regulations for infant sleep products that went into effect in 2022 and 2023. The CPSC established a safety standard for crib mattresses which included after-market mattresses for play yards and non-full-size cribs that went into effect August 2022. Five products were recalled for violating this rule. Additionally, in June 2022, the CPSC's Infant Sleep Products Rule went into effect, which requires any product marketed or intended for infant sleep to meet one or more of the federal safety standards for cribs, bassinets and cradles, play yards, or bedside sleepers. This rule was further expanded in 2023 by implementation of the Safe Sleep for Babies Act that Congress passed in 2022, by banning padded crib bumpers and inclined sleep products, products that have led to hundreds of deaths. Four recalls this year were due to violating these new infant sleep product regulations.

### **TOY RECALLS**

While 2022 saw the most toy recalls in the last decade (33) mostly due to choking and lead hazards, this year had some significant recalls of certain toy types.

#### FIRST WATER BEAD RECALL IN A DECADE

The CPSC recalled a water bead product for the first time since 2013. Water beads, often sold as toys, in craft kits, or marketed as sensory tools for children are small, water-absorbing, colorful balls of super absorbent polymer and can grow up to 100 times their original size when exposed to water.

The Chuckle & Roar Ultimate Water Beads
Activity Kits were sold exclusively at Target and
were recalled after an infant death was
reported. A 10-month-old child died from
swallowing the beads and a 9-month-old child
was seriously injured from intestinal
obstructions that required surgery to remove.

The two other water bead products that were recalled in 2013, the Be Amazing! Toys Monster Science and Super Star Science Colossal Water Balls and Doodlebutt Jelly BeadZ Jumbo BeadZ and Magic Growing Fruity Fun Toys were also recalled for serious ingestion hazards and were recalled after the CPSC received reports of an eight-month-old girl ingesting the beads and requiring surgery.

In January 2024, major retailers including Target, Amazon, Walmart, Kohl's, Shein, Jo-Ann Stores, eBay announced that they will stop selling water beads marketed for children, and online retailers like Etsy and AliExpress have removed all water beads products.

#### **INCREASE IN MAGNET TOY RECALLS**

There were two recalls and 12 unilateral notifications for small powerful magnet products. When high-powered magnets are swallowed, they can attract to each other through internal body tissue. This can result in perforations, twisting and/or blockage of the intestines, infection, blood poisoning and death. A CPSC federal standard went into effect in December 2022 requiring loose or separable magnets in magnet products intended for both adults and children to be either too large to swallow, or weak enough to reduce the risk of internal injuries when swallowed.

### OUTDOOR AND SPORTS RECALLS LEAD TO INJURIES AND DEATHS

There were 15 outdoor and sports products recalled this year, and the number of recalls for this category have been increasing steadily over the past several years. Products in this category have also caused injuries and deaths. Two deaths were due to the Jetson Electric Bikes 42-volt Jetson Rogue self-balancing scooters/hoverboards that caused a fire after the lithium-ion batteries in the product overheated killing a 10-year-old girl and her 15-year-old sister.

Injuries caused by products in this category include one from the Jetson Electric Bikes Nova and Star 3-Wheel Kick Scooters due to a fall hazard, 19 from the woom Bikes USA Original Kids' Bicycles due to a fall hazard, three from the Soft Play Sky Wheels due to injury hazard, and two from the Polaris Industries RZR 200 Youth Recreational Off-Road Vehicles due to injury hazards.

### RECALLS BY HAZARD

Burn hazards were the top hazard category with 25 recalls, while choking hazards followed with 21 recalls. There were 11 recalls due to suffocation hazards, which was higher than previous years.




Figure 7. Burn and Choking Hazards had the Highest Number of Recalls in 2023

### NUMBER OF BURN/FIRE HAZARD RECALLS HIGHEST THIS YEAR

This year there were 25 recalls due to burn hazards and all were clothing products that failed to meet the federal flammability standards for children's sleepwear. Most of these clothing products were sold directly by third party vendors from other countries through e-commerce sites. Twenty-one of these products were manufactured in China, while the four others in the UK and Bangladesh, India, Peru, and Turkey. There were also three recalls due to fire hazards that contained batteries that could overheat and cause fires. Two were nursery products, both baby monitors, and the other was an outdoor and sports product, a self-balancing scooter/hoverboard. Two of these products, the Jetson Electric Bikes 42-volt Jetson Rogue self-balancing scooters/hoverboards and the Philips Avent Digital Video Baby Monitors both contained rechargeable lithium-ion batteries that have been connected to fires. The Jetson Electric Bikes 42-volt Jetson Rogue self-balancing scooters/hoverboards were recalled after a 10-year-old girl and her 15-year-old sister died from a fire that fire marshals determined was started by the scooter/hoverboard.

Additionally, the CPSC also released a unilateral notification for the Toos Elite Electric Scooters after two people, including a seven-year-old, died in an apartment fire that fire officials determined was caused by the lithium-ion battery in the scooter. The notification was released after Toos Urban Ride refused to conduct an acceptable recall with the CPSC.

### NUMBER OF CHOKING HAZARD RECALLS SECOND HIGHEST THIS YEAR

Of the 21 recalls due to choking hazards, 12 were toys, three were nursery products, and two were clothing products that had small parts that could detach and pose a choking hazard. One of these toy products, the Epoch Everlasting Play Calico Critters Animal Figures and Sets sold with Bottle and Pacifier Accessories caused two deaths, a 2-year-old child and a 9-month-old child. The toy water bead product the Chuckle & Roar Ultimate Water Beads Activity Kits resulted in a 10-month-old's death and a 9-month-old with serious injuries.

The other two recalls were two candy products that consisted of a plastic bottle with a rolling ball that holds a sour liquid candy. The CPSC received two reports of the rolling ball detaching from the container causing a choking hazard for children and a report of a seven-year-old girl that died after choking on the Cocco Candy and KGR Distribution Cocco's Candy Rolling Candy product. This led to the recall of another similar product, the Candy Dynamics Slime Licker Sour Rolling Liquid Candies that had about 70 million units recalled.

### DEATHS REPORTED PRIOR TO RECALL




Figure 8. Slight Increase in Deaths Reported Prior to Recall in 2023

In 2023, there were six deaths reported before a product was recalled. This was an increase compared to the previous year during which there were four deaths prior to recall. Three deaths were due to choking hazards, one was due to ingestion hazards from a water beads product, and the last two were due to fire hazards from a lithiumion battery in a scooter/hoverboard product.

### INJURIES REPORTED PRIOR TO RECALL




Figure 9. Number of Injuries Increases in 2023

There were 106 injuries reported prior to recall this year, an increase from 2022 (47 injuries). Two products were most concerning. The Zuru Robo Alive Junior Baby Shark Sing & Swim Bath Toys (full-size) and Robo Alive Junior Mini Baby Shark Swimming Bath Toys (mini-size) had 7.5 million units recalled and 12 impalement injuries, lacerations and puncture wounds, including to children's genital, anorectal and facial areas. Nine of these required medical attention or stitches. The Chuckle & Roar Ultimate Water Beads Activity Kits had a report that a 9-month-old child was seriously injured from swallowing the water beads which caused an intestinal obstruction requiring surgery to remove them. This product also caused the death of a 10-month-old child who also swallowed the water beads. Appendix D details all products that were recalled with injuries reported prior to recall.

### INCIDENTS REPORTED PRIOR TO RECALL

In 2023, 471 incidents were reported, lower than the previous year when 867 incidents were reported prior to recall. This is also the lowest number of incidents reported since 2014. The Dorel Juvenile Group Cosco Jump, Spin & Play Activity Centers had the most incidents reported at 141 reports, and it had the highest number of injuries reported as well (38 injuries). The second highest was the woom Bikes USA Original Kids' Bicycles which had 77 reported incidents, and also had the second highest number of injuries reported (19 injuries).






Figure 10. Number of Incidents Before Recall Decrease

### **SOCIAL MEDIA**

#### **CPSC SOCIAL MEDIA USAGE**

Social media is a powerful tool for disseminating information and can be more effectively used in communicating children's product recalls than other avenues. Since 2017, KID has monitored the percentage of children's product recalls that the CPSC posted to their social media pages and announcements have been consistently underutilized. Facebook data has been tracked since 2017 while Instagram and Twitter data has been tracked since 2018. CPSC social media usage has largely remained the same for the past few years. In 2023, CPSC posted 44% of the children's products recalled to Facebook, a slight rise from 2022 (42%). Twitter usage fell slightly to 45% in 2023 from 47% in 2022.

The CPSC's use of Instagram increased in 2022 from previous years and the agency further increased usage of Instagram into 2023. The CPSC mainly utilized Instagram stories to post recalls on Instagram in 2023 and 2022 and would then pin their stories to their highlights bar. However, this means that consumers have to scroll through hundreds of stories to find recalls. This also meant that if a user was not following the CPSC's account, the post would not be shown to them when it was first posted as a story. This can make finding recalls days later difficult.

The CPSC's social media usage is also inconsistent. The agency does not post every recall on all three of their accounts. The general trend is that the CPSC only posts products that have many injuries and deaths, or if the companies have their own social media accounts and/or a large social media presence. This means that many products sold through third party sellers like those found on Amazon and eBay are not posted because these sellers usually do not have a social media presence.




Figure 11. Percentage of Recalls Posted on Social Media by CPSC Remains Low,

### **COMPANIES' SOCIAL MEDIA USAGE**

Since 2014, KID has tracked recalling companies' use of social media to announce recalls. Of the 101 children's products that were recalled this year, 52% of companies had a Facebook, 40% had a Twitter, and 52% had an Instagram. Of those companies that had social media accounts 36% posted on Facebook, 25% on Twitter, and 30% on Instagram. Social media usage by companies has remained relatively low since KID has been tracking posts. This year, Twitter usage fell slightly and Instagram slightly rose.




Figure 12. Percentage of Recalls Posted on Social Media by Recalling Companies Remains Low



# CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Recalls are the most direct way of warning consumers about unsafe products and removing them from the market and homes. KID's report shows that while the CPSC is making progress in recalling more dangerous products, more must be done to make the recalls effective in removing products from homes. Also, more must be done by companies and the CPSC to use all tools in their arsenal to get recalled products out of homes – especially using social media and disseminating newly translated recall press releases to Spanish-speaking communities. The difficulty in assessing the effectiveness of recalls means that many dangerous recalled products remain in homes and childcare facilities and can still cause injury or death. The CPSC's use of unilateral notifications is a powerful tool to warn consumers about hazardous products when they have not yet been recalled.

#### KID RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:

- Recalling companies must use all tools at their disposal to retrieve recalled products. This includes social media for every recall, and other measures such as direct notification to consumers and marketing recalls to the same extent as they market products. Additionally, they should work with retailers, marketers, consumer groups and state and local governments to spread information about the recall more widely and to reach more consumers.
- The CPSC's social media has been getting attention due to their eclectic and viral posts. The CPSC could capitalize on this to reach more parents and caregivers of young children who are active on these sites by posting all recalls as soon as they are announced. ### **METHODOLOGY**

A children's product is defined as any product designed or intended for the care of or use by children under age 14. KID has expanded this definition to include other products that pose risks specifically to children such as window blinds and dressers. Children's products were further categorized for this report by the type of product (clothing, furniture, kitchenware, nursery, outdoor & sports, and toys). More details on the products can be found in Appendix A.

Since 2014, KID has monitored the social media usage by manufacturers to report recalled products. When a product is recalled, KID checks if the recalling company has a Facebook, Twitter and/or Instagram account. If the manufacturer has any of these three social media platforms, it is noted for each applicable platform whether a recalled item was posted. KID has also monitored the usage of social media by the CPSC since 2017 when the CPSC joined Facebook. The CPSC's Twitter and Instagram pages have been monitored for recalled children's product posts since 2018. KID monitors Instagram posts and stories.

KID obtained all recall information for this report from press releases issued jointly by product manufacturers and the CPSC. KID also looked at press releases by the CPSC to warn consumers about unsafe products when the company and CPSC could not reach an adequate recall. Press releases outline the incidents, injuries, deaths, and failures caused by the product prior to the date of recall or warning. All numbers, facts, and figures contained in this report originated in these press releases.

Only children's products under the jurisdiction of the CPSC were considered. This excludes car seats and booster seats regulated by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. However, the CPSC does have oversight of car seats that also function as infant carriers.
